#### ORDER CALLING DIRECTORS ELECTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 49.103, Texas Water Code, as amended, and Section 41.001, Texas Election Code, as amended, Horizon Regional Municipal Utility District (the "District") is required to hold a Directors Election on the first (1st) Saturday in May, 2025 (the "Election"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the District deems it necessary and appropriate to establish the procedures whereby such election may be held; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the number of registered voters in the District is more than 1,000, which pursuant to Section 85.005(b), Election Code, as amended, requires that the polls be open for carly voting for a minimum of eight (8) hours each weekday, except legal state holidays; and

WHEREAS, Section 61.012 of the Texas Election Code requires that the District must provide at least one (1) accessible voting system in each polling place used in a Texas election on or after January 1, 2006, which must comply with State and federal laws setting the requirements for voting systems that permit voters with physical disabilities to cast a secret ballot; and

WHEREAS, Sections 123.032 and 123.035 of the Texas Election Code authorize the acquisition of voting systems by local political subdivisions and further mandate certain minimum requirements for contracts relating to the acquisition of such voting systems; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it will conduct a joint election with El Paso County pursuant to the Joint Election Agreement and Contract for Election Services; and

WHEREAS, the Election will be administered by the El Paso County Elections Administrator pursuant to the Joint Election Agreement and Contract for Election Services;

WHEREAS, the Office of the Texas Secretary of State has certified that the Electronic Voting System provided by El Paso County is an accessible voting system that may legally be used in Texas elections.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HORIZON REGIONAL MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT, THAT:

I.

An election shall be held for and within the District between the hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm on the 3rd day of May, 2025 for the election of Director **Position Nos. 1 and 2** for the District, each of which shall serve a four (4) year term. Election Day polling places are those listed in Exhibit "A" and/or such other places as designated by El Paso County.

Such election shall be held and conducted in all respects as provided by law for general elections, except as provided by Chapter 49, Texas Water Code, as amended.

Ш.

All duly qualified resident voters of the District shall be allowed to vote at such Election.

IV.

The Board hereby designates its General Manager, Carlos McGinnis, 14100 Horizon Blvd., Horizon City, Texas 79928, and its Attorney, Johnson Petrov LLP, 2929 Allen Parkway, Suite 3150, Houston, Texas 77019, as authorized representatives for purposes of the Election, and any and all documents required to be filed with or notices required to be given by the Secretary of the Board under the provisions of the Election Code shall be deemed filed and notices shall be deemed given if filed with or given to the Board's General Manager or Attorney.

V.

Written applications for the listing of a candidate for director on the ballot, signed by the candidate, shall be received by the General Manager or Attorney until 5:00 p.m. on **Friday**, **February 14, 2025**. No person shall be nominated or elected a director unless such person is qualified to serve under applicable law. Write-in candidates must make a declaration of write-in candidacy with the District's appointed agent no later than 5:00 p.m. on **Tuesday**, **February 18**, **2025**.

VI.

The Secretary or any Assistant Secretary of the Board shall notify the President or Vice President of the Board not earlier than 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 18, 2025, which time is past the deadline in which write-in candidates shall have to declare their intent to run for office and past the deadline for receipt of Applications for Place on Ballot, for purposes of this Election the names of any candidates for Director Position Nos. 1 and 2 on the Board of the District. If each candidate whose name is to appear on the ballot is unopposed, no proposition is to appear on the ballot, and no person has declared as a write-in candidate prior to the deadline therefore, then the Secretary or any Assistant Secretary of the Board shall certify in writing that a candidate is unopposed for election in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.052, Election Code, as amended, no earlier than Friday, February 21, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. Upon receipt of such certification, the Board, by Order, and in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.053, Election Code, as amended, may declare each unopposed candidate elected to office, in which case the Election provided for in this Order shall not be held.

VII.

The Secretary of the Board shall give notice of the purpose of such Election, the offices to be voted on, and the early voting and Election Day polling places pursuant to Section 4.003(a)(2), Election Code, as amended, by posting Notice of Election with the requisite El Paso County translation(s) in a public place in each election precinct that is within the boundaries of the District, not later than **Saturday**, April 12, 2025. In addition, pursuant to Section 4.003(b),

Election Code, as amended, a Notice of Election with the requisite El Paso County translation(s) shall be posted on the bulletin board used for posting notices of meetings of the Board of the District not later than **Saturday**, **April 12**, **2025**; provided, further, that if the polling location has changed from the previous election, Notice of Election with the requisite El Paso County translation(s) shall also be posted at the location of the old polling place.

In addition to the notices required to be given under the Election Code as stated hereinabove, the Board of the District has elected to cause Notice of Election with the requisite El Paso County translation(s) to be published in a newspaper with general circulation in El Paso County, Texas or of general circulation within the area of the District, not later than ten (10) days prior to the Election Day to afford all residents an opportunity to participate in the Election.

VIII.

The ballots for such Election shall be prepared in sufficient number and in conformity with the Texas Election Code, as amended, and shall be substantially as follows:

Mark the ballot by placing an "X" in the square beside the one (1) candidate of your choice for each position.

The order in which the candidates' names appear on such ballot shall be determined at a drawing held under the supervision of the Secretary of the Board in compliance with the Texas Election Code, as amended. Any write-in votes cast in said Election shall not be counted unless the name appears on the list of write-in candidates.

IX.

Voting shall be by the use of electronic and paper ballots in English and Spanish. The ballots used in the Election shall have printed thereon the names of the candidates for the office

of director and blank spaces for write-in votes. The voter may vote for up to one (1) person per position for director by writing the candidates name beside the position number or in the blank spaces provided if there are any declared write-in candidates.

X.

The County of El Paso Elections Department shall appoint the Presiding Judge and any required Alternate Presiding Judge or Clerks, and is authorized to do all things necessary and proper to conduct the election for the District. The General Manager of the District is authorized to enter into and execute an agreement with El Paso County to conduct the Election.

XI.

Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at locations attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and/or such other locations as designated by El Paso County.

XII.

Early voting ballots for voting by mail may be obtained from and mailed to the early voting clerk at El Paso County Elections Department, El Paso County Courthouse, 500 East San Antonio, #314, El Paso, El Paso County, Texas 79901.

XIII.

Immediately after such Election, the election officers shall make returns of the results in triplicate. One copy shall be retained by the Presiding Judge, one copy shall be delivered to the President of the Board, and one copy shall be delivered to the Secretary of the Board.

XIV.

The President or Vice President and Secretary or any Assistant Secretary of the Board are hereby authorized to evidence adoption of this Order and directed to do any and all things legal and necessary in connection with the holding and consummation of such election and to carry out the intent hereof.

XV.

If any provision, section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Order is held by any reason to be invalid, such invalid portions shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Order.
